



Construction methods

- a) Cut (60 to 80cm by 100 to 140cm)



- b) Fold in half (inside out)



- c) Sew then turn right way




- d) Load, twist and wear

- A) Cut (60 to 80cm by 100 to 140cm)




- b) Fold in half (inside out)

- d) Cut slit and edge




- a) Cut (30 to 40cm by 200 to 240cm) and finish short edges



- b) Fold ends to the middle




- c) Sew then turn right way


a) Cut (60 to 80cm by 100 to 140cm) and finish long edges



b) Fold sides to the middle




c) Sew then turn right way
